Descripton	<p>This track will focus on the best IS research undertaken in and relevant to the specific context of developing countries. Within the ECIS area (AIS Region 2), there are many Developing and Emerging Countries, notably in Africa, the Middle East and Eastern Europe, whose scholars will be encouraged to submit their best work. We intend to focus on topics that are of direct relevance to improving the quality of life in developing countries. Submitting authors may be located anywhere in the world, but the research context and focus should place developing countries at the centre of their work. Single country studies are perfectly acceptable, but we also encourage cross-cultural studies, including combinations that involve both developing and developed countries.</p> <p>We do not have a preference for method or epistemology. However, we expect that research will be empirical in nature and will involve the collection and analysis of data directly from developing country contexts. We are particularly interested in theory development work that foregrounds the developing country context, i.e. seeks to identify indigenous constructs and then measures how those constructs affect the behaviour of individuals, teams and organisations.</p>
